Dallow area parking consultation

Luton Council would like to give the residents in the Dallow area an opportunity to tell us what you think of proposals to address the parking situation in your road. The proposals are intended to alleviate a number of concerns raised by residents.

Our proposals are outlined in this leaflet however you also have an opportunity to suggest measures of your own.

Once all responses have been considered and if the decision is made to proceed, we will contact residents again as part of the statutory procedure to seek your views on the detailed proposals.

Tell us what you think

Our proposals

We are proposing to introduce parking controls to prevent all day commuter parking, thus make parking for residents and their visitors more readily available.

- on road parking would be limited to a maximum of 2 hours except for those displaying valid permits. Parking would be in marked bays only.
- we have reviewed current restrictions in an attempt to free up space for parking, but the needs to maintain traffic flow in the area will take priority over parking in accordance with our statutory duty.
- permits currently cost £50 per year per vehicle.
- visitors' permits cost £22 per book of ten and carers' permits cost £50 per year. The charges cover the annual administration costs of the scheme.
- purchasing a permit does not guarantee you a space.
- any match-day parking restrictions will remain (Clifton Road)

We will be introducing double yellow lines to all junctions that don't already have them to aid large vehicles turning. The restrictions will stretch 5-10m from the junctions.

We will look at each road and the responses received on an individual basis but will not be able to respond to individual responses or correspondence. Please bear in mind that this is not a vote. This consultation is intended to understand the wishes of the residents and to find a way forward in line with the statutory duty of the Council as the Highway Authority. The Plan shows the proposed restrictions for all roads in your area.

You should consider that if residents own more vehicles than there is space available a permit scheme will not resolve the parking problems and that the council does not have a duty to provide parking for your vehicle. The council has a sustainable travel initiative and encourages everyone who lives, works or travels in Luton - to change travel habits into more sustainable ways such as walking, cycling, use of public transport and car sharing.
